



## ENERGY GLOBE AWARD INVITATION PRESS RELEASE

Worcestershire based family business, Greeneering Limited, are delighted to have been invited to submit a project for the ENERGY GLOBE WORLD AWARD FOR SUSTAINABILITY. Invited organisations are all involved intensively with sustainability and have demonstrated outstanding performance in the field. The ENERGY GLOBE Ambassador to United Kingdom, Emeka Efe Osaji, presented the invitation to Greeneering Limited. In the letter of invitation he said that he was aware that Greeneering *“are involved intensively with sustainability... and ... have implemented an outstanding project in the field.”*

The ENERGY GLOBE World Award for Sustainability is today's most prominent environmental award worldwide. The competition is run by the ENERGY GLOBE Foundation (<http://www.energyglobe.info>) which was established in 1999. This competition seeks out innovative showcase projects and smart technologies capable of creating sustainable changes for life. The categories in which the award is presented represent the of 4 basic elements of life, as well as projects implemented by young people.

Annually the competition receives approximately 1000 project entries from more than 160 countries. It is awarded on a local, national and international level each year. The international award (under the title ENERGY GLOBE World Award for Sustainability) is awarded in five categories (Earth, Fire, Water, Air and Youth) and each of the winners receives €10,000 in prize money. In addition, the annual national awards distinguish the best projects in each of the participating nations.

On 5th June 2012 (World Environment Day), ENERGY GLOBE presented the national ENERGY GLOBE winners from 161 countries under the patronage of UNESCO. Discussions are currently taking place in order to hold future International ENERGY GLOBE World Award for Sustainability ceremonies at the UN Headquarters in New York.

Founded in February 2012, Greeneering is still finding its feet in the research and development arena, but has already experienced considerable growth. This includes being awarded two government funded competitive projects via the Technology Strategy Board. Greeneering was also recently selected as 1 of 4 finalists for the BECCI To Treat Challenge.

The Greeneering technology under development is primarily, but not exclusively, in green energy. Some of their developments are intended to be applied within domestic properties, whilst others are for commercial properties. In addition they also have some developments intended for use with vehicles and others for use with animals. This is definitely a small company with a big future. As Greeneering continues with their research and development work they are also seeking partnerships to help to exploit their technology and bring products to market.
